## **Submission Instructions Journal SEAMUS**

### **General**

Interested contributors should submit manuscripts by email. Manuscripts should be submitted in an editable format, such as a Microsoft Word document (\*.docx). The type of submission should be specified (e.g., scholarly article, review, studio, interview, report, tutorial, etc.). Main articles are generally 2,000 to 6,000 words. Reviews, tutorials, and other items tend to be shorter, around 500-1,000 words.

### **Preparing Your Submission**

Manuscripts should use Times New Roman size 12 or similar font, double-spacing, and no columns or other non-essential formatting. Long articles should be divided into sections with bold headings (no numbered headings). Manuscripts should be formatted and prepared using *The Chicago Manual of Style*, 18th edition (2024) as a guide. References should follow Author-Date format, with parenthetical citations in text as necessary. All references should be listed after the text of the article in a section labeled “References.” Footnotes should be avoided. Any computer code should be placed in fixed-width format to facilitate readability. The approximate location of each graphic (images, figures, musical examples, diagrams, etc.) should be indicated in the text by a (sequentially numbered) label and a brief caption. Graphics may be included within the body of the submission, but must also be sent as separate attachments (see below).

### **Supporting Materials**

Any graphics (including images, figures, musical examples, diagrams, etc.) should be submitted as separate individual files. If there are many files, please submit them as a single zip file or include an anonymized link to a shared folder. We recommend uncompressed graphic files such as TIFF at 300 dpi. We can support links to audio, video, and other types of supporting materials on a case by case basis.

### **AI Policy**

Authors are responsible for the contents of their own work, including its correctness and originality. This includes text, images, and all media associated with a given submission. AI tools should never be cited as an author or co-author. Where AI tools have been used in the creation of any aspect of a submission, the author must include a statement accompanying their submission describing the scope of such usage.
